DOMESTIC WORK IS ALSO CONSIDERED AS EMPLOYMENT!

Did you know that:

- You are entitled to a proper employment contract, to an agreement on work performance or to an agreement on working activity
- You are entitled to a fair wage
- You are entitled to a break during work
- You have the right to work only 8 hours a day
- You are entitled to national health insurance and certain social benefits
- You have the right to know your job description and not to provide extra services
- You are entitled to be treated fairly and with dignity

Working as a migrant domestic worker does not have to be illegal!

DO YOU HAVE A BUSINESS LICENSE AND WORK AS A MIGRANT DOMESTIC WORKER?

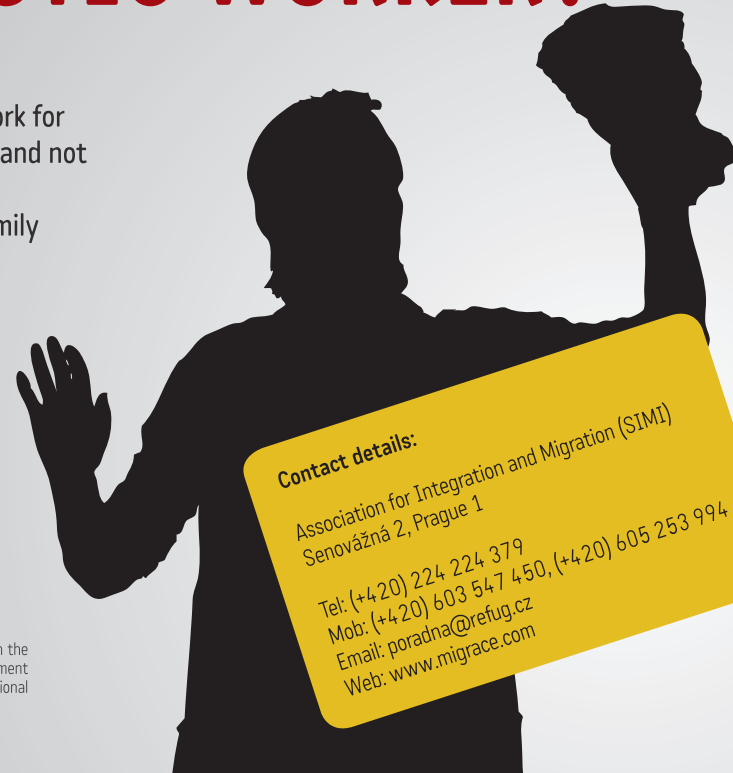
Did you know that:

- You have the right to sign an agreement with the family you work for
- You have the right to know your obligations under the contract and not to provide extra services
- You have the right (and obligation) to issue an invoice to the family
- You are entitled to fair compensation for services you provide
- You are entitled to have a break during work
- You are entitled to be treated fairly and with dignity
